 - Bachelor's degree for all academic tutoring positions
 - ABA tutors must have minimum of 2 years of college (*see Position 6*)
 - If you opt to tutor in basic math or reading; you must attend a math and/or reading workshop in order to meet NCES standards
 - Licensure required for positions 7b, 11, 12, 14, 15, & 17

- 3. At the group interview, you will be asked to indicate:**
 - The tutor position(s) of interest (Positions 1 through 17)
 - Your geographic preference(s)
 - Your availability; day and time preference(s)

- 4. If you chose Tutor Positions 1, 2, 5, 7, 8, 14, & 15**

QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor’s degree required for all positions except Position 6. No prior teaching experience is required. Teacher licensure or certification, teaching experience and classroom management are a plus. NCES seeks committed instructors that are creative, flexible, sensitive, and patient. (*Positions 10 - 12 & 14 - 16 require licensure*)

PAY RATE:

\$18 to 21/hr - Depending on the subject, course and training required.

Available Tutor Positions

- # 1 Tutor reading** (phonics, spelling, and comprehension), **writing and study skills**
Reading workshop training required (see p.4)
- # 2 Tutor basic Math** (computation skills, math concepts, and word problems)
Math workshop training required (see p.4)
- # 3a Tutor high school math** (high school algebra, geometry and calculus)
- #3b Tutor high school science** (chemistry, physics and limited positions in biology)
No workshop training required. You must know the subject matter, without needing to “brush up”.
- # 4 Tutor foreign language;** especially Spanish
Some tutors needed for Sign Language, French, (German and Latin occasionally)
No workshop training required. No workshop training required. You must know the subject matter, without needing to “brush up”.
- # 5 Work with children with Asperger’s, PDD or mild autism** in their home 2 to 12 hours per week, working on academic curriculum. Experience with special education, particularly autism, is invaluable. Scheduled sessions are usually during the day with the individual family. Positions become available in other Northeast OH cities based on individual client needs. Minimum bachelor degree required.
Workshop training required (in reading AND math, if students have basic skills deficits.) (see p.4)
- # 6 Work with children ages 3 to 8 with Autism. Teach Applied Behavioral Analysis or Verbal Behavior,** 4 to 10 hours per week in 2 - 2.5 hour sessions. Minimum of 2 years college required. Prefer college major in education, speech, OT, PT, psychology, sociology, nursing, etc. These positions are available throughout Ohio, and you may be added to the list of tutors sent to families in need of ABA tutors. If inexperienced with Applied Behavioral Analysis or Verbal Behavior, on-the-job training may be provided. Pay rate varies by experience.
No workshop training required.
- # 7a Home School -- Work with individual students not enrolled in a school** 5 to 10 hours per week. You will be responsible for teaching all related coursework.
Workshop training may be required in reading and/or math. (see p.4)
- #7b Tutoring for Credit –** Teach a student a course they need for high school graduation. ODE licensure required.
- #8 Day-time School program in an Eastside charter school. Students are in grades 3 to 8.** Ohio Achievement Test preparation program running from October through April. Program is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30 am until 2:30 pm. More details to follow at the group interviews.

- # 9 School programs** are currently being developed for the 2008-09 school year in Akron and Cleveland (*East and West side and inner ring suburbs*), and Lorain-Elyria areas. This includes potential after-school programming as well as others. More details will be given as they become available at the group interview and future CareerBoard postings. ***Workshop training required in reading and/or math.*** (see p.4)
- #10 Licensed Ohio Department of Education special education or intervention specialists** to oversee our Autism Scholarship clients. Training and support provided at no charge. Pay rate \$30/hr.
- #11 BCBA consultants** to work with our Autism Program clients to oversee their ABA or VBA programs and train their tutors. Pay rate variable based on experience not at our tutoring rates.
- #12 Licensed RN's** to tutor nursing courses to LPN, Respiratory Therapists and Paramedics one day per week for four hours in our Solon offices. Pay rate \$30/hr.
- #13 SAT and ACT test preparation** - no training required but experience is required for these positions.
- #14 Licensed Ohio Department of Education Intervention Specialist** to provide inclusion in a middle school for language arts and mathematics. (*Three full-time positions with benefits*) If interested, submit your resume to oreid_gha@sbcglobal.net Salary will be discussed during interviewing. Training is required in reading and math as listed on this ad.
- #15 Licensed Ohio Department of Education Intervention Specialist** to provide inclusion in a middle school for language arts and mathematics. One half-time position (*mornings*). From the WEST (Western and Southern Cuyahoga County, Lorain County)

1. Take **I-480** to **Rte 422 east** and **I-271 north**. Merge right to the **Rte 422 east lanes** – go **.05 mi**
2. Take the **Harper Rd** exit
3. Turn **right** at **Harper Rd** - go **0.5 mi** Harper Rd becomes **Cochran Rd**
4. Continue on **Cochran Rd** - go **0.8 mi**
5. Turn **left** at **Solon Rd** - go **0.6 mi**
6. Arrive at **31300 Solon Rd, Suite 17**
7. Suite 17 is in the second building BEHIND the “pond”.

From the North (Lake County, Northeastern Cuyahoga County)

1. Take **I-271 South** toward Columbus.
2. Take the **US-422 E** exit **27A-B** to **Warren/Cleveland** - go **3.0 mi**
3. Take the **Harper Rd** exit
4. Turn **right** at **Harper Rd** - go **0.5 mi** Harper Rd becomes **Cochran Rd**
5. Continue on **Cochran Rd** - go **0.8 mi**
6. Turn **left** at **Solon Rd** - go **0.6 mi**
7. Arrive at **31300 Solon Rd, 17**
8. Suite 17 is in the second building BEHIND the “pond”.

From the EAST (Geauga, Portage, Mahoning Counties)

1. Take **Rte 422** west to exit **Rte 91**(Solon)
2. Turn **left** on **Rte 91**, then next right on Solon Road – go **0.2 mi**
3. Continue on **Solon Road** -- go **1.5 mi**
4. Arrive at **31300 Solon Road, Suite 17**
5. Suite 17 is in the second building BEHIND the “pond”.

From the SOUTH (Summit County)

1. Take **I-271 north**.
2. Take **exit 23** to **Broadway Ave** (OH-14) **Forbes Rd**. -- go **.0.2 mi**
3. Continue on **Fair Oaks Rd** – go **0.3 mi**
4. Turn **right** at **Forbes Rd** – go **1.3 mi**
5. Turn **left** at **Richmond Rd** – go **0.9 mi**
6. Turn **right** at **Solon Rd** – go **1.5 mi**
